Dear Choir Leaders,

Sutton Sings Festival 2025: 'Song Journey' KS1: Monday 9th & Tuesday 10th June 2025 St. Andrew's United Reformed Church, Cheam (SM2 7HF)

We are looking forward to welcoming you and your choirs at St. Andrew's United Reformed Church in a few weeks for our *Sutton Sings Festival*! Please read the following final information, which includes some reminders about how the day will work.

Here are a few reminders and requests about things to do ahead of the day...

- During the rehearsals, your choir are welcome to sit and watch the other choirs rehearse, however, they will need to sit in silence so they might like to bring a book with them. Alternatively, if it is a nice day, you are welcome to sit outside during your break. We recommend that your singers bring a packed lunch/snack and water bottle.
- We ask that the choirs are dressed in smart school uniform for the concerts. This will enable us to identify individual schools on the day quickly and efficiently.
- Due to space restrictions, we would ask that children keep belongings to a minimum.
- Each school will be provided with 2 plastic boxes labelled with your school's name. All belongings should be placed in these boxes before the performance for storage during the concert. These boxes will be returned to you at the end of the concert for you to distribute back to your children.
- During the concert, your school choir will sit and watch the other choirs perform. The massed sing will take place towards the end of the concert. We would ask that your supervising staff help us with these transitions on and off stage to ensure that everything runs smoothly.
- We would love it if there is a confident child in your choir who might like to introduce your school and solo items before your choir performs. Please practice this before the concert day!
